

REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING

April 2, 2025

The regular monthly meeting of the Dennison Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Sheila Weaver. After Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag, roll call was taken as follows:

BUSINESS:

DELINQUENT SEWER ACCOUNTS - The secretary reported that there are nine sewer customers who are delinquent and own over \$500.00. In August 2024, five of the customers had liens put on their property, but four of the properties do not have a lien. A motion was made by Michael Mack, second by Chris Bender, to request the township attorney, Dan Mullen, file liens on the four properties. All voted in favor, motion carried.

ENGINEERING REPORT – NONE – Sheila Weaver suggested an email be sent to Christine Mildner from Barry Isett to check the status of the Ice Lake Bridge project and the Hollenback Creek project.

ZONING REPORT - One permit was issued in March for a pole building on Glen Oaks Lane. The township sent a letter to the owner of the property at 64 W. Nescopeck Lane based on the complaint the township received from a neighbor about garbage being thrown all over the property. The owner of 64 W. Nescopeck Lane called and said he does not own the property that has the garbage on it. After further investigation it was determined that the correct address was 62 W. Nescopeck Lane. A letter has been sent to that property owner.

ROAD REPORT – Roadmaster Jim Yackiel reported he did maintenance on the loader, cleaned up some branches on several streets, and cleaned up around the recycle bins. He also reported that the street sign and post for Peat Moss Road is missing. He will check to make sure it is not laying in the weeds and if he can't find it, he will order a new one. He also ordered oil for the furnace.

ROAD INSPECTION – Supervisors will do annual road inspection on Wednesday, April 30th at 5:00 p.m.

FIRE REPORT - There were 6 calls during the month of March, 7-3/4 hours of service, 10 1/2 hours of training, and 2 hours of maintenance. Five were in Dennison Township and one in White Haven Borough. Ten new air packs were ordered to be delivered in approximately 8 weeks.
