

REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING

January 6, 2024

The regular monthly meeting of the Dennison Township Board of Supervisors was called to order immediately after the Reorganizational Meeting by Chairman Sheila Weaver. Those attending:

BUSINESS:

ORDINANCE NO. 1 – 2025 SUPERVISORS COMPENSATION ANNUAL SALARY – A motion was made by Michael Mack, second by Chris Bender, to enact the Supervisors Compensation Salary Ordinance which will increase the annual supervisors' salary to \$3,145.00 for any elected township supervisor entering office after the effective date of the ordinance. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

ENGINEERING REPORT – Sheila Weaver reported that the YMCA submitted plans for a Land Development but they have not received zoning approval so this will need to be worked out. Sheila Weaver also stated that there is a problem with the Odor Control Station project at Clarence Fisher's property because Aqua was told to submit a Land Development Plan after receiving zoning approval and they did not do that.

ZONING REPORT – Sheila Weaver reported that the township is in the process of revising the zoning fee schedule. One thing that is missing on the zoning application is demolition but it is referenced on the fee schedule, therefore, some things need to be clarified before the fee schedule can be revised.

ROAD REPORT – Jim Yackiel reported he cleaned up branches from some roads and cleaned out some culverts and plowed the parking lot. He also reported the salt shed is half full.

FIRE REPORT – There were five calls with 5.5 hours of service and 2.5 hours of maintenance. One call was in Dennison Township, one in Wright Township and three in Foster Township. Two dwelling structures, one chimney fire, one false alarm with good intent and one transformer fire.

ADJOURNMENT - On a motion by Michael Mack second by Chris Bender, the meeting was adjourned at 6:16 P.M. All voted in favor.
