

REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING

January 5, 2026

The regular monthly meeting of the Dennison Township Supervisors was called to order by Chairman, Sheila Weaver, at 6:10 p.m., immediately following the Reorganization Meeting. Those in attendance were:

The minutes of the December 3, 2025, meeting were approved on a motion by Chris Bender, second by Angela Kaminski. There were no questions. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

The Treasurer Report was approved on a motion by Angela Kaminski, second by Chris Bender. There were no questions. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

The bills were read and approved to be paid on a motion by Angela Kaminski, second by Chris Bender. There were no questions. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

PNC BANK – A motion was made by Chris Bender to remove Michael Mack, Supervisor and Bruce Thomas, Supervisor as signatories for the three Dennison Township checking accounts at PNC Bank; to add Angela Kaminski, Supervisor and Chris Bender, Supervisor as signatories, and to retain Sheila Weaver, Supervisor and Kathleen Stortz, Secretary/Treasurer as signatories for the following Dennison Township's checking accounts:

Dennison Township General Fund – Account ending in 3600

Dennison Township State Road Fund – Account ending in 4220

Dennison Township Sewer Revenue – Account ending in 6366

Motion second by Angela Kaminski. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

POLICE REPORT – There was 53.58 hours of patrol and 32.45 hours for incidents for a total of 86.03 hours for the month of December.

ZONING REPORT – None

ROAD REPORT - Due to the absence of Roadmaster Jim Yackiel, the secretary reported that during the month of December he plowed snow, cleared branches off roads, and checked the Lake Francis gate.

Chairman Weaver reported that the township received some complaints regarding the roads the day after the ice storm. She said she believed one of the complaints came in before the plow got to the area the person was complaining about. She said she checked the roads in Ramblewood, and they were in good shape, but the Tunnel Road was terrible. She requested that people be patient, the plow driver cannot get to everyone first. Chris Bender stated some of the roads that

people complained about are county roads, not township roads. It was also noted that we had more storms in December than all of last year and the year before.

Cheryl Graff requested help with 4th Street, which is a one-way street and very narrow. Cars are going the wrong way on that street and at the end of the road there is a car parked, partially on the road, going the wrong way. Cheryl also said there was a sign at the corner of 4th and Middleburg that said “No Parking Between Signs” but the sign is missing. Sheila Weaver suggested people get a photo of any cars going the wrong way which can be turned over to the police. She also said she would speak to Roadmaster Jim Yackiel regarding signage.

FIRE REPORT – The secretary read the fire report for December. There were seventeen calls, 25.25 hours of service, and 3.5 hours of maintenance. Eleven calls were in Dennison Township, three in Foster Township, one in Penn Lake, one in Hazle Township and one in W right Township. There was a total of eighty-three calls in 2025.
