

REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING

March 11, 2026

The regular monthly meeting of the Dennison Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Sheila Weaver. After Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag, roll call was taken as follows:

The minutes of the February 11, 2026 regular monthly meeting were approved on a motion by Chris Bender, second by Angela Kaminski. There were no questions. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

The Treasurer’s Report was approved on a motion by Angela Kaminski, second by Chris Bender There were no questions. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

The bills were read. Frank Sitko asked what the bill for Sue Maranuk was for. Sheila Weaver informed him it was for cleaning the township building. A motion was made by Chris Bender, second by Angela Kaminski to approve payment of the bills. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

BUSINESS:

DGK INSURANCE – Jeff Kyle from DGK Insurance went over the township’s insurance package for the year 2026.

POLICE REPORT – There were 58.33 hours of patrol minutes, and 17.85 hours of incident minutes reported by the White Haven Police Department for the month of February.

AUDITOR MINUTES – The following minutes from the auditor’s reorganization which was held on January 6, 2026 were approved on a motion by Chris Bender, second by Angela Kaminski. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

The Dennison Township Board of Auditors held their reorganization meeting on Tuesday, January 6, 2026 at 7 p.m. in the Dennison Township Municipal Building. Auditors for 2026 are Sarah Weaver and Melony Clymer.

Meloney Clymer was elected Chairman. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Sarah Weaver was elected Secretary. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Meloney Clymer to establish the rate of pay for a supervisor working in any other capacity at \$15.00 per hour. Second by Sarah Weaver. All voted in favor. Motion by Meloney Clymer, second by Sarah Weaver to adjourn. Motion Carried.

COMCAST AGREEMENT - Comcast franchise agreement has been review by the township attorney. On a motion by Angela Kaminski, second by Chris Bender, the cable agreement with Comcast was approved. All voted in favor. Motion carried. The agreement with Comcast is in addition to the township’s agreement with Breezeline.

DATA CENTER ORDINANCE – Sheila Weaver reported that Angela Kaminski has been working on an ordinance regulating Data Centers in Dennison Township. A motion was made by Angela Kaminski second by Chris Bender to approve advertising adoption of the proposed ordinance, after review by the township attorney. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

DELINQUENT SEWER ACCOUNTS – Letters were sent to delinquent sewer customers and they have until March 15th to pay their bills or liens will be filed against their properties. A motion was made by Chris Bender, second by Angela Kaminski, to place liens on the customers who do not pay. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

ZONING REPORT -One zoning permit was issued in February for a pole barn.

ROAD REPORT – Roadmaster Jim Yackiel reported he checked roads last month. The “No Parking Between Signs” for fifth street were discussed again.

ICE LAKE BRIDGE PROJECT – The bids for the Ice Lake Bridge project were three and one half times the amount of the grant the township received. There were also problems with getting access from adjoining property owners to get access to the bridge. A motion was made by Angela Kaminski, second by Chris Bender to reject all bids. All voted in favor. Motion carried. A motion was made by Chris Bender, second by Angela Kaminski, to send a letter requesting an extension of the grant that the township has which will expire in June 2026 and to apply for additional funds. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

FIRE REPORT - There were 4 calls during the month of February, one dwelling structure, one motor vehicle accident, one welfare check and one EMS assist. There was 3.5 hours of man hours, and 7.5 hours of maintenance.

ROAD INSPECTION – The supervisors will hold annual road inspection on April 7th at 4 p.m.

ADJOURNMENT – On a motion by Angela Kaminski, second by Chris Bender, the meeting was adjourned at 6:50. Motion carried.
